McSHANE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY RECEIVES “2010 PROJECT OF THE YEAR” AWARD FROM CISCO

*(The Casa Morelos and Casa Maravilla Assignment Receives Top Honors in
“Residential Construction” Category for “2010 Pride in Construction” Awards)*

(Rosemont, Illinois) – Jeffrey A. Raday, President, of McShane Construction Company, is pleased to announce that the firm has been selected to receive the *2010 Project of the Year* award within the *Residential Construction* category on behalf of the Construction Industry Service Corporation (CISCO) as part of its *2010 Pride in Construction Award Program*. McShane Construction was selected for this prestigious award for the completion of the Casa Morelos and Casa Maravilla multi-family residences located in Chicago’s Pilsen neighborhood.

The annual awards program was introduced by CISCO in 2005 to recognize top quality union construction projects throughout the Chicago area within four categories, including New Construction – Chicago, New Construction – Suburbs, Residential Construction and Rehabilitation. Each entry was judged with regard to quality of construction, design, safety and its impact on the community.

“McShane Construction is honored to have been recognized by CISCO on behalf of these multi-family residential communities. It is a testament to McShane’s strong union relationships and also to the high quality work that our union subcontractors consistently perform,” remarks Raday.

Casa Morelos is a seven-story, 45-unit affordable housing apartment complex located at 2015 S. Morgan Street in Chicago, while Casa Maravilla is a five-story, 73-unit senior living rental development located at 2021 S. Morgan Street in Chicago. The two-building assignment was completed on behalf of owner, The Resurrection Project, a non-profit community organization.

The new Casa Morelos apartment residence provides one-, two- and three-bedroom affordable housing units for residents within the surrounding neighborhood. The multi-family property also offers a community/meeting room and on-site laundry facility.

Casa Maravilla consists of a combination of studios, one-, and two-bedroom rental units and offers amenities such as a dining area, community room, therapy room, library and recreation room. The rental complex provides affordable housing for seniors and also serves as the first senior citizen satellite center of the Chicago Department of Family & Support.

During construction, both Casa Morelos and Casa Maravilla were registered with the Chicago Green Homes program, a city-operated permitting system fostering environmentally - conscious construction and design practices.

A formal award presentation to the *2010 Pride in Construction Award Program* winners is scheduled on Friday, January 28, 2011.
