GLENCROFT SELECTS McSHANE CONSTRUCTION TO COMPLETE 24-UNIT SARAH'S PLACE MEMORY CARE RESIDENCE IN GLENDALE, ARIZONA

*(Single-Story, 15,000 S.F. Residential Complex to Include
60 Solar Panels to Promote Energy Efficiency)*

(Phoenix, Arizona) – M. Tracy Hammer, Vice President of McShane Construction Company's Phoenix, Arizona office, is pleased to announce that the firm was recently selected to provide construction services for Sarah's Place, a new 24-unit senior housing residence on behalf of owner, Glencroft, a provider of senior housing and assisted living facilities.

The new 15,000 square foot facility will be located at 6670 W. Butler Drive on the existing Glencroft senior living campus in Glendale, Arizona and will offer high-level care for individuals suffering from memory loss.

The project will feature 60 rooftop solar panels to facilitate the use of natural energy to power the residential complex. Solar energy will be utilized in conjunction with traditional energy systems. Salt River Project, one of Arizona's largest utilities, provided a grant for the purchase and installation of the equipment.

The complex will utilize wood frame construction and feature an attractive three-coat stucco exterior. The comfortable interior finishes will incorporate residential components that provide a soothing and inviting atmosphere for residents. In addition to individual living spaces, common areas will include a living room, dining area, activities center, library, den, beauty shop, two kitchens and several fireplaces.

McShane Construction recently completed a comprehensive renovation of Glencroft's care center dining hall and chapel that encompassed the reconstruction of several areas that provided an appealing upgrade of technology, color schemes and space utilization.

Glencroft is home to nearly 700 residents throughout apartments, assisted living facilities and a Medicare-certified care center.
