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McSHANE CONSTRUCTION COMPLETES 45-UNIT CASA MORELOS AFFORDABLE HOUSING COMMUNITY FOR THE RESURRECTION PROJECT

*(New 54,000 S.F. Rental Complex Provides Green
Construction in an Affordable Development in Chicago's Pilsen Neighborhood)*

(Rosemont, Illinois) - Jeffrey A. Raday, President of McShane Construction Company, is pleased to announce the recent completion of the seven-story, 54,000 square foot Casa Morelos affordable housing complex on behalf of developer, The Resurrection Project. The residential facility will feature 45 units of affordable rental housing located at 2015 S. Morgan Street in the Pilsen neighborhood of Chicago, Illinois.

This project marks the company's initial multi-family assignment from The Resurrection Project, a not-for-profit affordable housing developer. McShane Construction is also constructing Casa Maravilla, a five-story, 73-unit affordable senior rental residence for The Resurrection Project. Casa Maravilla is located adjacent to Casa Morelos at 2021 S. Morgan Street in Chicago and is scheduled for a June 2010 completion.

The new Casa Morelos apartment residence provides one-, two- and three-bedroom affordable housing units for residents within the surrounding neighborhood. The multi-family

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property offers a community/meeting room and on-site laundry facility. The cast-in-place structure features an attractive brick veneer exterior highlighted by two entrance canopies with Alucabond finished cornices above the main entry.

During construction, Casa Morelos was registered with the Chicago Green Homes program, a city-operated permitting system fostering environmental construction and design practices. The completed project contains a green roof, weather-resistant windows, ENERGY STAR appliances, recycled construction materials, low volatile organic compound (VOC) paint and permeable pavement. The project also offers an extremely efficient boiler and hot water system that carries a 93% efficiency rating. The former brownfield site is located within one-half mile of mass transit, offering residents a convenient and environmentally-friendly transportation option.

Weese Langley Weese Architects Ltd. provided the architectural services for this new affordable housing residential development.
